Students Taking Action with Recognition (STAR) Events are Competitive Events in which members compete and are recognized for proficiency and achievement in chapter and individual projects, leadership skills, and career preparation. STAR Events allow students to compete individually or as a team. Students choose from nearly 30 STAR events, all which recognize participants who demonstrate their knowledge, skills, and abilities to actively identify an issue concerning families, careers, or communities, research the topic, and develop and implement a project to advocate for positive change.

All students who participate in a STAR event are recognized at the State Leadership Conference. A sponsorship of a STAR event helps to offset the cost of event operations and awards.

Sponsor names are recognized before the selected events. Sponsors are eligible to present awards on stage to students.
