Event Details: (Level 1, 2, or 3. This is an individual event)

Directions: FCCLA Creed Speaking and Interpretation, an individual event, recognizes members for their ability to recite and interpret the FCCLA creed within the context of their personal philosophy. This event provides an opportunity to gain self-confidence in public speaking while learning the values and philosophy expressed by the organization in which they hold membership.

- The individual participant will recite the creed from memory to the evaluators. There is a maximum of 2 minutes for the creed presentation. Once the participant has begun reciting the creed, he/she may not stop and start over.
- Participants may not use note cards or other presentation elements.

Identification: Make sure the project is labeled with member name, chapter, and level.

Submission: Turn in at the registration desk.

PARTICIPANT QUESTIONS

There is no formal oral presentation for this event, however, participants should be prepared to answer the following questions at the designated set up time. These questions are designed to be asked conversationally. Participants will be evaluated on the quality of their answer, not on their presentation of responses.

- 1. What was your concern?
- 2. What was your goal?
- 3. What did you learn?
- 4. What would you change if you did this event again?
