Event Details: (Level 1, 2, or 3. This is an individual or team event)

Directions: FCS Project Showcase, an individual or team event, recognizes members for their projects developed in FCS courses. Projects must be FCS curriculum-related: interpersonal communication, career exploration, family health, teaching skills, child development, nutrition and fitness, fashion, interior design, and entrepreneurship.

Identification: Make sure the project is labeled with member name(s), chapter, and level.

Submission: Turn in at the registration desk.

SPECIFICATIONS

Display

Participants may submit ten (10) 8 ½" x 11" pages in a binder or a poster/display board. The poster/display board should be no bigger than 22" x 28" and include the following components:

Description of Project	What class the project was made in and the process of completing it.
Project Goals	Goals are related to FCS curriculum that includes, but not limited to: interpersonal communication, career exploration, family health, teaching skills, child development, clothing and textiles, nutrition and fitness, fashion, interior design, entrepreneurship, etc.
Photos and Graphics	Photos and graphics should show the work of the project. Students may use props or final products as part of the display (no food should be brought)

PARTICIPANT QUESTIONS

There is no formal oral presentation for this event, however, participants should be prepared to answer the following questions at the designated set up time. These questions are designed to be asked conversationally. Participants will be evaluated on the quality of their answer, not on their presentation of responses.

- 1. What was your concern?
- 2. What was your goal?
- 3. What did you learn?
- 4. What would you change if you did this event again?
