



Event Details: (Level 1, 2, or 3. This is an individual event)

Directions: Fashion Sketch recognizes members for their ability to design and sketch a croquis based upon a provided design scenario.

Identification: Make sure the project is labeled with member name, chapter, and level.

Submission: Turn in at the registration desk.

SPECIFICATIONS

Participants will design, sketch, and color one outfit on a croquis based on the theme provided below.

Participants will complete the Principles and Elements of Design worksheet and submit it with the Explanation of Design.

Fashion Sketching

Sketching Techniques	Produce a design that is neatly rendered, sketched, colored, and includes extra details (zippers, stitching, buttons, seam lines, etc.) Participants may use a croquette of their choice.
Design Scenario	Design a modern outfit for a formal event based on historical clothing styles from a decade in the 1900s. Be sure to include the decade in your information. The fashion design sketch must meet acceptable standards of modesty/appropriateness for this setting.
Accessories	Incorporate accessories into sketch - jewelry, gloves, hats, sunglasses, scarves, etc.
Creative & Original Designs	Execute original thorough and planned out designs of croquis
Craftsmanship	Croquis is clean and crisp with no excessive eraser marks. The croquis has been outlined in black marker or colored pencil.

Event Components

All components should be included in a 2-pocket folder with name, chapter, and category listed on the outside.

Fashion Sketch	Completed fashion sketch
Explanation of Design	Up to one 8 ½" by 11" page. Explain the design choices that have been made, including the relation to the state that was selected.
Elements and Principles of Design Worksheet	One 8 ½" x 11" page of the completed Elements and Principles of Design Worksheet (pg 25 of the 2022-2023 Skill Demonstration Event Guidelines) which explains how the four elements of design and the five principles of design have been used in the sketch.

PARTICIPANT QUESTIONS

There is no formal oral presentation for this event, however, participants should be prepared to answer the following questions at the designated set up time. These questions are designed to be asked conversationally. Participants will be evaluated on the quality of their answer, not on their presentation of responses.

1. What was your concern?
2. What was your goal?
